

EDUCATION COMMITTEE PROGRAM 2025-2027

The Education Committee acknowledges the importance of inclusivity in knowledge sharing and is committed to ensuring that educational materials, curricula, and training opportunities are accessible to all healthcare professionals, regardless of the resources available in their setting.

A key focus is ensuring that ultrasound training reaches underserved areas of the world with sustainable programmes and verifiable quality.

The programme of the Education Committee 2025-2027 is:

- Actively follow the development of the Centres of Education (COE) review

Prepare the WFUMB Ultrasound Curriculum for COE at two levels (Fundamental and Advanced), competency-based and modular, suitable for low-resource settings under the leadership of the Chair of the COE Task Force.

Provide oversight of the WFUMB website for the education and COE section, ensuring content is up-to-date, accessible, and aligned with the educational strategy.

Develop and enhance eLearning initiatives, including the "Case of the Month", "Image Challenge", and a proposed webinar for MASU 2027, under the leadership of the Chair of the eLearning Task Force.

Collaborate with the Publication Committee and the Safety Committee to publish reports and guidelines on educational and safety topics relevant to ultrasound training.
